

Bean Bag Toss Design

Materials for Boards

2 – 24" x 48" Plywood
2 – 24" x 12" Plywood
4 – Hinges + Screws

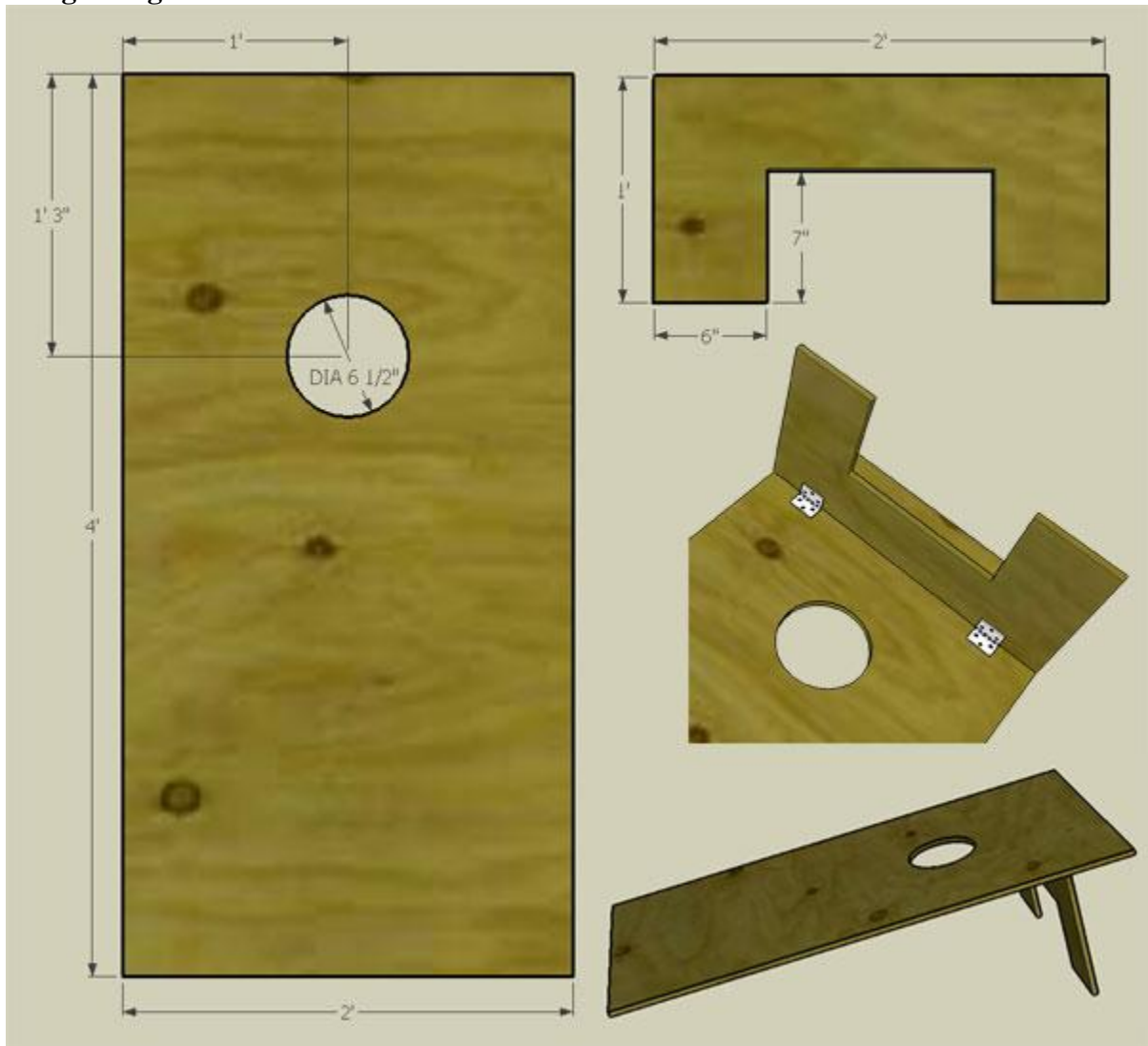
Tools

Jigsaw
Screwdriver
Sewing Machine

Materials for Bean Bags

Fabric for Bean Bags – 2 Different Colors
– Each bag is about 6 1/2" square
Small Dried Beans or Rice

Design Diagram and Dimensions:



These components will make a total of 2 Boards and 6 Bean Bags.

Detailed Instructions on assembling the Boards

1. Purchase all the components
2. Cut the plywood into 2 pieces 24" wide and 48" long.
3. Cut 2 pieces of plywood 24" wide and 12" long.
4. Cut the two 24"x12" pieces to look like a "U". 6" in from both sides and then 7" in from the bottom.
5. Cut the hole in both of the 24"x48" pieces. The center of the hole will be 15" from the top and 12" from the sides. The diameter of the hole will be 6.5"
6. Screw in the stands to the main boards. The stand should be 6 inches from the top of the board and the hinges will be screwed in to the board and the stand. There will be 2 hinges per board.

Detailed Instructions on assembling the Bean Bags

1. Purchase all the components
2. Cut the fabric into 6-1/2" squares
3. Double serge two of the squares together around three of the edges to create a good seal.
4. Fill the bag with the rice or dried beans.
5. Double serge the last side of the square to seal up the bag.

Alternate Option for the Bean Bags

1. Purchase the pre-designed bags from a store. Some of the online stores can be found using the links on the side of my website and others you may be able to find in your local gaming store (ie – Games by James).
